OUR VISION:- "Every member of the body of Christ, living in readiness for the kingdom of God." Special emphasis must be placed on the word <u>READINESS</u>.


WHO IS A STEWARD?



O Lord our Lord, how excellent is thy name in all the earth! Who has set thy glory above the heavens.... When I consider thy heavens, the work of thy fingers, the moon and the stars, which thou hast ordained;



What is man, that thou art mindful of him? And the son of man that thou visit him? For thou hast made him a little lower than the angels, and hast crowned him with glory and honor.



Thou made him to have dominion over the works of thy hands; thou hast put all things under his feet. Psalm 8:1-6

Man was to bear God's image, both in outward resemblance and in character. Christ alone is 'the express image' (Hebrews1:3) of the father; but man was formed in the likeness of God. His mind was capable of comprehending divine things.

His affections were pure; his appetites and passions were under the control of reason. He was holy and happy in bearing the image of God and in perfect obedience to his will.






"The position of a steward is one of dignity, because his master trusts him.

"Whether we recognize it or not, we are stewards, supplied by God with talents and facilities, and placed in the world to do a work appointed by Him." Ed 137








